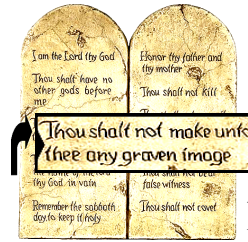
Drinks (w/required lids) are allowed in the Sanctasium.

God will Tolerate No Rivals

Exodus 20:1-7, Romans 11:22; Colossians 1:15-19

Introduction: We will be judged by the GRACE, FORGIVENESS and UNCONDITIONAL LOVE of JESUS but does that mean that the laws of God no longer apply? Do the 10 Commandments have anything to say to us today? I believe they do and I believe the first 4 laws are serious conditions relating to our love relationship with Jesus! And God spoke all these words: "I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery. "You shall have no other gods before me. "You shall not make for yourself an image in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below. You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the parents to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me, but showing love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commandments. You shall not misuse the name of the LORD your God, for the LORD will not hold anyone guiltless who misuses his name. Exodus 20:1-7
