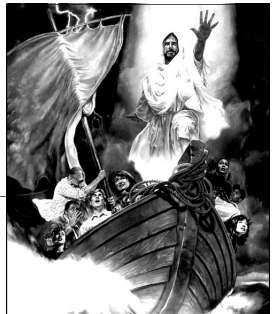

# How to Face the Storms of Life by Faith

Scripture Text: Acts 27:1-44 ; 2 Timothy 4:16-18

"Men, I can see that our voyage is going to be disastrous and bring great loss to ship and cargo, and to our own lives also... before long the wind of hurricane force ... but now I urge you to keep up your courage, because not one of you will be lost ..."  
Acts 27:10, 14, 22

**Introduction:** There's a country song about a woman driving her car and loses control and she cries out, "Jesus take the wheel!" I've been there, have you? Paul, by the end of Acts, let's go. He knows that his life is in God's hands and there's little he can do about it because he had totally, fully, unconditionally released his life into God's hands! He foretells the upcoming shipwreck "Men, I can SEE THAT our voyage is going to be disastrous" but you know — he knows that he is going to make it to Rome. Jesus has met with him and told him that He wanted Paul to tell his testimony—just like he had in Jerusalem. So he knew he was going to survive the storm and as he prayed it was revealed to him that all on the ship would be saved but they'd lose everything. His admonition: "I urge you to keep up your courage because none of you will be lost" Good WORD — hold on to that one! You may need it!
