"Who is My Mother?"

Matthew 12:48-49; 20:20-23

But Jesus answered the one who was telling Him and said, "Who is My mother and who are My brothers? And stretching out His hand toward His disciples, He said, "Behold My mother and My brothers! "For whoever does the will of My Father who is in heaven, he is My brother and sister and mother." Matthew 12:47-50

Introduction: We'll begin this morning by ending last Sunday's message in regards to the fires of life and how they affect us. We are either **burning in** with the fires of the Holy Spirit, **burning out** when we allow ourselves to overload and/or take on more of the loads of life than God intended or **burning up** if we fail to prepare for eternity before we die. If you place in oil and light it, the wick remains and the flame only burns the oil. However, if the oil runs out, the wick burns. As long as there is oil, the wick doesn't burn. As long as we are living in dependence on the power of the Holy Spirit, we don't burn out. This is Mother's Day. It's a day to honor our moms. Mothers, in our society or any society, need desperately to have an internal fire burning if they are going to survive. Let's look at two moms in the Bible who wanted the absolute best for their kids - for eternity.

I. Burning In - Out - Up

- † Guarding the Flame
- † Facing yourself before God
- † Hell on earth;
- † Hell beyond earth!

II. Salome, Mother of James and John

- † Mothers want their kids at the top
- † The price for the top seats is total sacrifice of self

III. Mary, the earthly Mother of Jesus

- † Blessed above all Mothers - Ever!
- † Lived the greatest heartache of any mom in history.

IV. Can you drink from this Cup

"You don't know what you are asking," Jesus said to them. "Can you drink the cup I am going to drink?" "We can," they answered. Jesus said to them, "You will indeed drink from my cup, but to sit at my right or left is not for me to grant. These places belong to those for whom they have been prepared by my Father." Matthew 20:22-23
