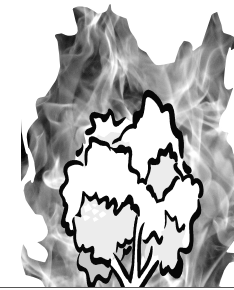

The **Café** and **Bookstore** are open before and between the Celebrations.

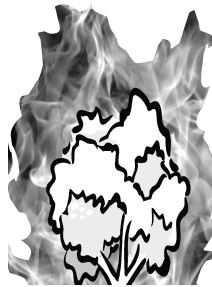

"Burning In; Burning Out; Burning Up"

Exodus 3:1-15; Matthew 33:10-33; Luke 24:13-21; 1 Corinthians 15:58



Introduction: Imagine a wick that is placed in oil, and then lit. If the oil runs out, the wick burns. As long as there is oil, the wick doesn't burn. As long as we are living in dependence on the power of the Holy Spirit, we don't burn out. The question to ask: what's burning?

This message is part of a two part message intended for ME and maybe for you, too. The BURNING BUSH burned internally and remained ON FIRE without consuming the bush! That's the internal flame of God at work.

We **Burning in** with the fires of the Holy Spirit.

Burning out is when we allow ourselves to overload and/or take on more of the loads of life than God intended. **Burning up** here is giving up and eternally leads to the flames that can consume the soul in destruction! Where are you this morning?

I. Burning In

- † Taking off your shoes;
- † Admitting your weaknesses;
- † Knowing WHO God is;
- † Walking by faith forward.

II. Burning Out

- † Recognizing the battles;
- † Guarding the Flame;
- † Facing yourself before God.

III. Burning Up

- † Hell on earth;
- † Hell beyond earth!
