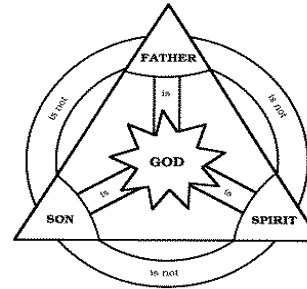



Are You Ready? Emergency Preparedness for Your Home and Family



We all know that disasters can occur any where and any time. Just in the recent past, our communities have had to deal with ice storms, tornadoes, floods and power outages.

Also, we can name many other potential disasters that could occur. It is important to learn how you and your family can be prepared to deal with a disaster at your home, what to do if you need to evacuate, or how you can provide yourself a long-term in-place shelter. You are invited to attend this free class that will give you the basics of emergency preparedness, including how to make a disaster supply kit and how you can be ready to be self-sufficient for at least three days. In addition, participants will learn about long-term water and food storage. Resources about emergency preparedness will also be provided.
