Scripture: Romans 10; Isaiah 52:7



Introduction: *Everyone who calls upon the Name of the Lord will be saved* - now that is GOOD NEWS. Simple, to the point and very directive to an action on our part. That was the full message of Romans 9. Paul has led us to the full direction of our own salvation and now he picks up Isaiah's mantle to take this Good News to the world. He not only takes it but challenges us to do likewise! John the Baptist cried, "prepare the way for the Lord make straight paths for Him." (Mark 1:3) Good News: "if you confess with your mouth, 'Jesus is Lord' and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved." (Romans 10:9) I challenge you to carry that news as a calling to everyone you meet!

I. "Everyone who CALLS ON THE NAME OF THE LORD shall be saved!" (10:13)

II. "See, I lay in Zion a stone that causes men to stumble and a rock that makes them fall, and the one who trusts in Him will be put to shame." (9:33)

III. Beautiful feet are the Worn out Feet: "...and having shod YOUR FEET WITH THE PREPARATION OF THE GOSPEL OF PEACE." (Ephesians 6:15)

IV. And the STONES CRY OUT - "I was found by those who did not seek Me: I revealed Myself to those who did not ask of Me." (10:20)
