Scripture: Romans 7-8:1



Introduction: The God-intended Christian life is not the life of doing the evil which we should hate and failing to do the good that which we should want to do (Romans 7:19). The God-intended Christ following life is not a life of captivity and bondage to sin (Rom. 7:23). Jesus came to set us free (John 8:31-36)! It is not His desire that we should live in perpetual defeat and failure and frustration days without end. Paul now moves us from a renunciation of SIN to how it relates to the LAW as set forth from God (Old Testament). The God-intended Christian life frees us both from the death sentence and from the guilt of sin.
